

Arsenic concentrations in public-supply wells

The red dots on this map indicate where elevated arsenic was detected in untreated groundwater withdrawn from public-supply wells. The Ohio EPA requires that water from public-water systems meet health standards, so the water may be treated before being distributed to the public.

Aquifers in some parts of Ohio are not represented on this map because public-supply wells tend to be located in geographic areas with relatively high populations, and in aquifers that produce relatively large amounts of water.
